

The first Cuban Centros de Hoja “center of the sheet”

The Cuban government began by printing three centros de hoja in 1926, except they had no gutters. Instead there are vertical and horizontal lines that divide the sheet into four panes of 100 stamps in each pane. That is 400 stamps on one sheet.
