Just how many sheets were issued for any given issue? A 2 centavo stamp was the standard postage, and produced the most sheets. As many as 32,000 sheets of



100 stamps were issued by Cuba for many of the Communications Employees Retirement series, such as here. In 1948, as few as 250 sheets of the one peso "Death of Antonio Maceo" were printed, and, as previously stated, only 200 of each of the entire (14) imperforate Matanzas sheets were printed in 1936.
